Stadium

Stadium Capacity: 3500 seats

Parking: Home team-west side, Visitor team-east side Rental Fee: \$1,500 (split between both schools)

Estimated Game Administration Fee: \$1,500 (does not include officials or 15% UIL fee)

Trophy is optional-adds \$225.00 to the cost of the stadium

Playing Field

Only emergency vehicles may be parked inside the stadium. No vehicles are allowed on the field and/or track surface (trailers, golf carts, etc.).

All equipment on wheels will be transported along the outside of the field area.

Only school personnel and team support staff are allowed on the sideline with the team. Cheerleaders, drill team, and band members must be in uniform to be present on the sideline.

No metal spikes or cleats may be worn.

No live mascots.

Food, gum, sunflower seeds and tobacco are prohibited at all times around or on the field area.

No Gatorade or other sugar-based, colored products are allowed on the field.

Props that will mark or cut the field surface will not be permitted.

Victory lines should be limited to cheerleaders and drill team only.

No painted paper run-through signs are allowed on the field.

Spectators are not allowed on the field before or after the game.

All air horns have to be agreed upon by both schools and will park at the north end of the stadium.

Dressing Rooms

Training tables will be provided along with any ice that is needed.

Decoration of the locker rooms is not allowed.

MISD will provide soap for showers, but no towels.

Bleachers

Spectators must sit in the stands and stay off of the rails.

The band and drill team will be seated in the stands on the south end of the bleachers.

All signs and banners must promote the school team and program. Negative signs towards the opponent are not allowed. At the closure of the event all signs must be removed and taken home.

Parking

Free parking.

Band bus parking will be assigned and marked by cones.

Team buses (both home and visitor teams) will park in the fenced parking at the north end of the stadium by the field house.

General Facility

Security will be provided on each side of the stadium.

No firearms are allowed.

State law and school district policies will be in effect concerning alcoholic beverages and controlled substances.

The use of tobacco products in any form is prohibited on all school district property.

Confetti, balloons, or similar items are not permitted in the stadium.

No sound systems will be allowed in the stadium.

Glass bottles and containers are not allowed in the stadium.

No pyrotechnics may be used in the facility.

Tailgate parties are permitted on each school's side and must conform to all stadium rules.

Ticket Booths & Gates

Gates will open 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to the game time for spectators. Home gates are located on the west side and visitor's gates are on the east side of the stadium.

Band members and drill team will enter through their assigned home or visitor's gate.

No outside food or drink may be brought into stadium.

No pets are allowed except for guide dogs.

Backpacks may be subject to search.

Important: The use of noisemakers or air horns must be mutually agreed upon prior to the game.


