

COMMUNITY AND STUDENT ENGAGEMENT LOCAL ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM

The Texas Education Code (39.0545) and House Bill 5 require school districts to evaluate their district and each of their campuses for community and student engagement in the following areas:

- Community and Parent Involvement
- Digital Learning Environment
- Dropout Prevention
- Fine Arts
- Gifted and Talented Services
- Second Language Acquisition
- Wellness and Physical Education
- 21st Century Workforce Development
- District and Campus Compliance

Districts must assign a performance rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable to the district, and each campus, based on locally-determined criteria. State statute does not permit the Texas Education Agency to determine the criteria that can be used for these evaluations. Districts must submit their locally-determined performance ratings to TEA.

McGregor ISD utilized multiple surveys to compile data to determine a final rating. Groups surveyed included:

- Students (Grades 6-12)
- Parents/Guardians
- Campus Leadership/Staff
- Citizens of McGregor (Vision 2030 Survey)
- District Administration

In addition, a review of social media outlets was conducted. Survey results and the social media review were converted into scores on a scale of 0-3. The average score for each indicator was used to determine the final ratings for each campus. The campus scores were averaged to arrive at a final rating for the district.

The numerical ratings were converted to the required exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable performance ratings as described below:

Points	Performance Rating
0 - .5	Unacceptable
.6 - 1.5	Acceptable
1.6 - 2.5	Recognized
2.6 - 3	Exemplary
